Getting to the Priory Rooms

Delegates are encouraged to travel to The Priory Rooms using public transport. There are numerous public NCP car parks within walking distance of the centre for delegate parking.

Rail

We are located approximately 7 minutes walk from New Street Station, where there are regular train services from all parts of the country. Trains run every half hour from London Euston – the journey time is approximately 1hr 40 mins. To reach us from New Street Station, exit the station through the main ticket barriers and travel up the escalators into the Pallasades Shopping Centre. Turn left to exit the Centre via the ramp. Corporation Street is ahead – continue up passing House of Fraser on your left. At the Square Peg, turn left and walk up the road passing the Minorities Shopping Arcade. Our driveway is on the right hand side.

Road

Please note that only pre-booked organiser and disabled parking is available on site. Delegates should make their way to one of the public car parks indicated on the attached map.

From M6 South or North-West

Leave the M6 at junction 6 and follow the A38(M). Follow signs to 'City Centre, Bromsgrove (A38)'. Do not take any exit to left. Go over the fly-over and then indicate left to leave the Queensway at St. Chads Circus. Take the 1st exit and when approaching Colmore Circus go around it clockwise, avoiding the route signposted 'City Centre/Colmore Row' At the Old Square island go right (3rd exit) and drive approx. 50meters down Corporation Street (Square Peg will be on your right) and then turn right into Bull Street. Keep in the right hand lane, our driveway is on the right opposite the bus island.

From M5 South-West

Leave the M5 at junction 3 and travel towards Birmingham City Centre along the A456 (Hagley Road) for 5 miles to the Five Ways Island. This is easily distinguishable as it is surrounded by large

office blocks and a Tesco Store. Keep in the outside lane and go under the island into Broad Street, using the underpass. Drive along Broad Street (The International Convention Centre will be on your left) to the Paradise Circus island. Take the 2nd exit at this island and drive down Gt. Charles Queensway to St. Chad's Circus. Keep in the right hand lane of the slip road and then take the first available right turn and drive in the left hand lane towards Colmore Circus (Wesleyan building in its centre). Keep straight on but at the Old Square island, go right (3rd exit) and drive approx. 50meters down Corporation Street (Square Peg will be on your right) and then turn right into Bull Street. Keep in the right hand lane, our driveway is on the right opposite the bus island.

From M40 Oxford and South

Arrive on the M42 and travel west towards the M5. Travel North on the M5 leaving at junction 3. (Read directions from M5 South-West)

From M42 East Midlands

Join the M6 heading towards Birmingham Central and leave M6 at junction 6. (Read directions from M6 South or North-West)
